Health care is reaping more profits than big banks.

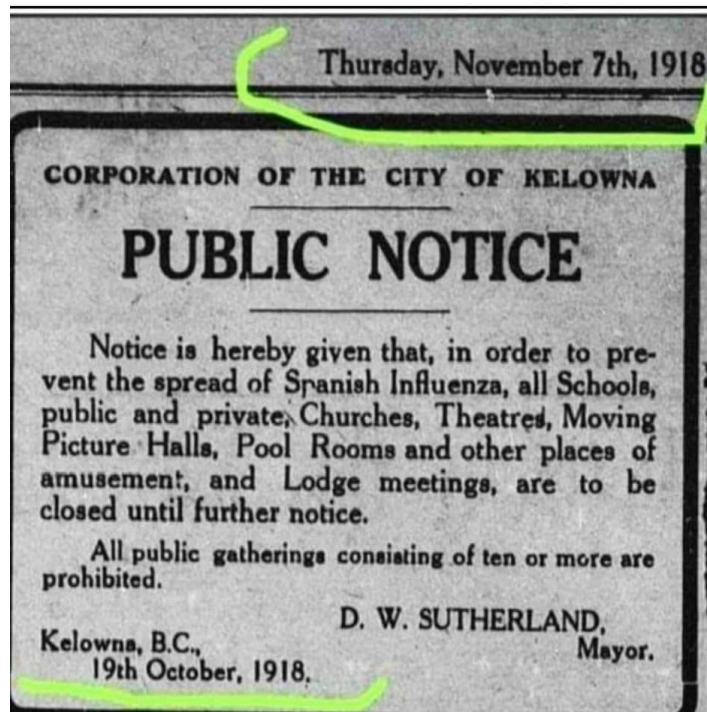
He's insulted every minority, women, families of fallen soldiers, farmers, cities, the sick, poor and middle class, allies and other countries, even his supporters if they recognized it.

TIMELINE OF TRUMP'S COVID_19 STATEMENTS
