## Dear friend,

Over the last few weeks, we've seen a dramatic increase in the pace of Vote Forward letter writing for The Big Send. When we first launched our 2020 campaigns in January, some savvy friends assured me that we would see this kind of acceleration. I didn't really believe it at the time, but I'm starting to now. So THANK YOU for everything you're doing! I have a feeling we're going to continue to be surprised, in a good way, in the months ahead.

Because it now seems that all of the voters in many of Vote Forward's 2020 campaigns will be claimed sooner than we expected, we're beginning the process of expanding our reach. We're working on a plan to increase the size of the campaigns in our existing states. That will happen soon. For now, we're adding new political campaigns in three states, **Montana**, **Nevada** and **New Hampshire**.

The rationale for political campaigns in these three states is two-fold: At the presidential level, Democrats must shore up their electoral position in Nevada and New Hampshire, two of the most vulnerable states on the map; at the U.S. Senate level, Democrats have a clear and urgent opportunity to flip Montana's Senate seat, and with it, win a Senate majority.

If you have a particular affinity for any of these states because you call one of them home, or have family or friends who live there, or just really like the state bird, we invite you to participate in one of them. You'll see them as options when you click the "Switch Campaign" link on your dashboard. You can also adopt Democratic-leaning voters from these campaigns using these buttons:

Separately, we're adding a campaign in service of our core mission of increasing participation among historically underrepresented communities in <u>Nevada</u>. If you'd like to write letters to voters in Nevada through this campaign, look for the "NVGOTV2020A" campaign on your Dashboard.

*Postcards to Voters* are friendly, handwritten reminders from volunteers to targeted voters giving Democrats a winning edge in close, key races coast to coast.

What started on March 11, 2017 with sharing 5 addresses apiece to 5 volunteers on Facebook so that they could mail postcards to voters in Jon Ossoff's race grew in one month to 1,200+ volunteers nationwide and over 51,000 postcards mailed.



Now, we consist of over 75,000+ volunteers in every state (including Alaska and Hawaii) who have written close to 8 million postcards to voters in over 200 key, close elections.

We use an interactive texting service (Abby The Address Bot) to assign addresses to our trusted, returning volunteers. For new volunteers and those organizing postcard parties around the country, we use a commercial Help Desk system to streamline and automate email requests.

Another commercial business intelligence package crunches the numbers so we always know who our top volunteers are by campaign, a heat-map showing where the postcards are being written by zip code around the country, and other essential dashboards to manage an operation that now averages 5,000 voter addresses assigned daily.
