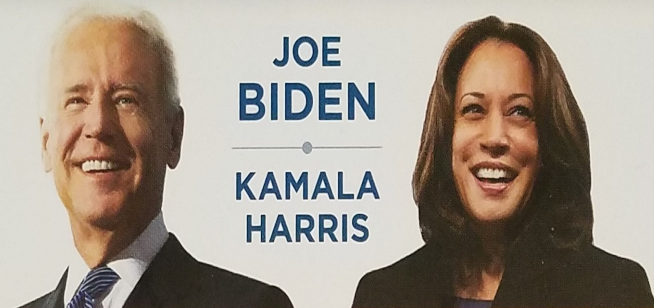

14	YES	Continues stem cell research funding to develop treatments and cures for chronic and life-threatening diseases.
