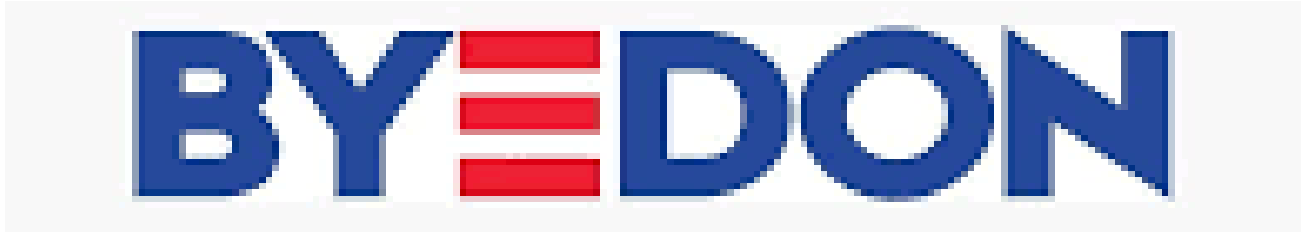

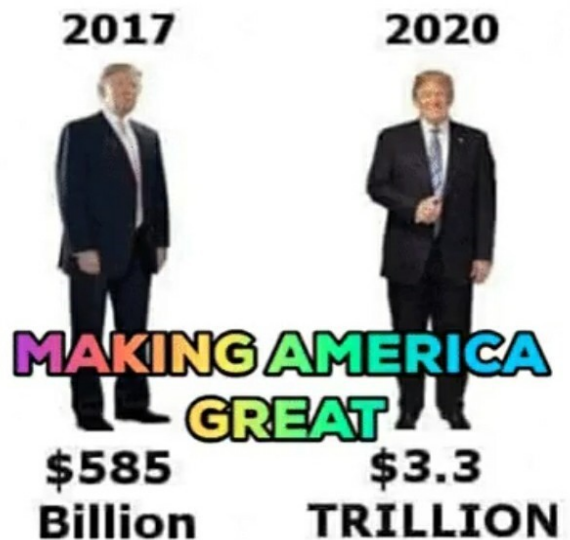


Healthcare in Japan

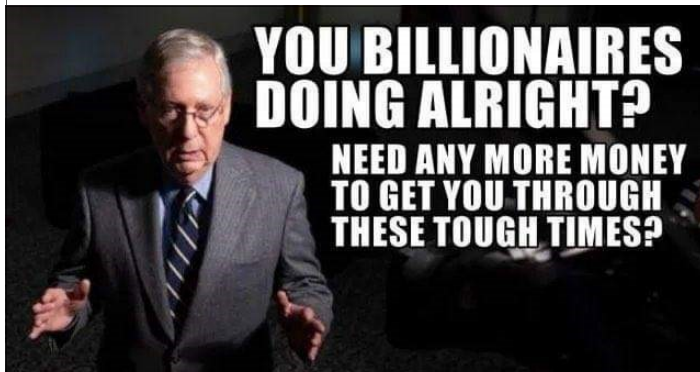
Massachusetts House Passes Democrat Amendment Legalizing Abortions Up to Birth

It's Friday so you should know that if the minimum wage had increased at the rate of productivity since 1960, it would be \$22.50. Instead, it's \$7.25.

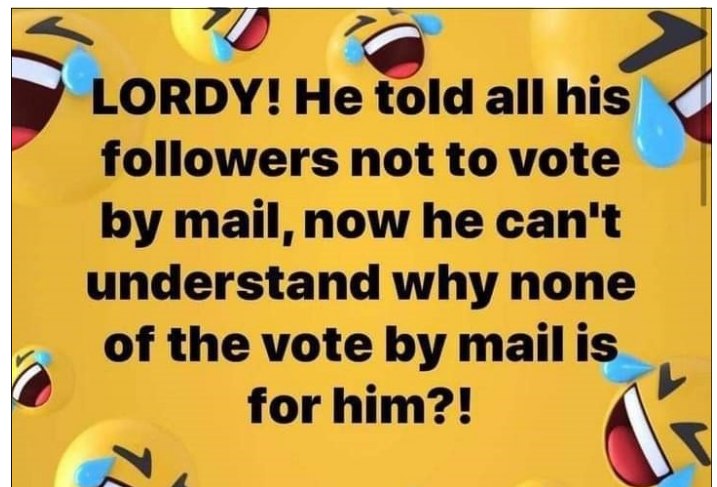
That's \$15.25 per hour for 60 years that's disappeared from the pockets of low income workers...

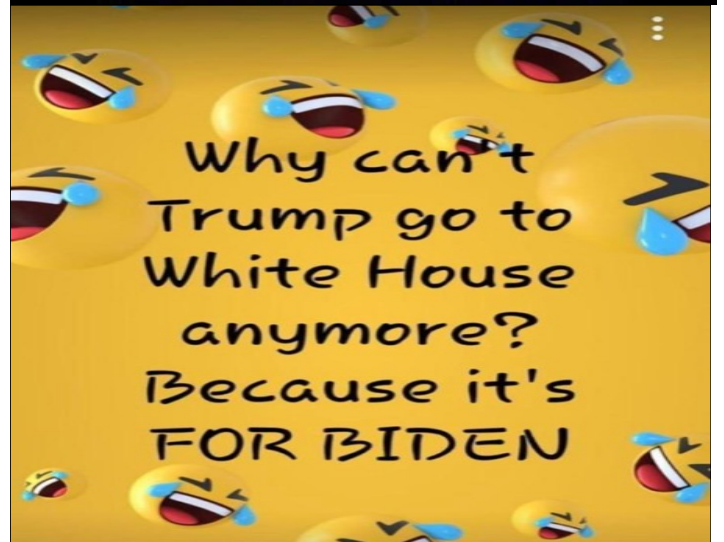

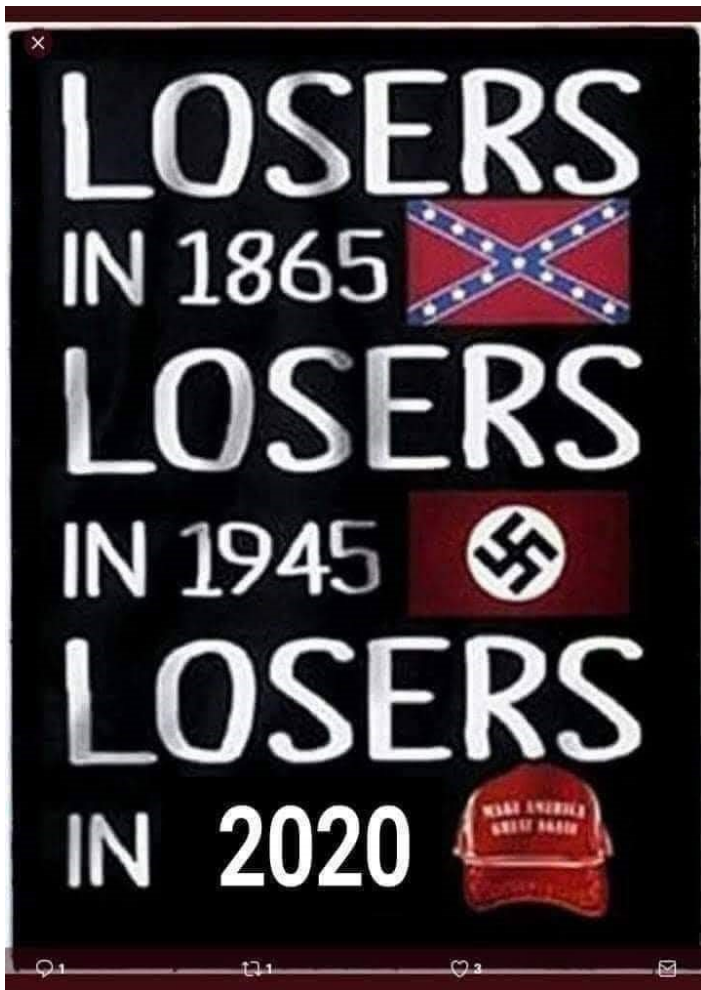
