Help Secure the Senate?

None of the candidates for Georgia's two senate seats secured 50% of the vote so, according to Georgia law, the top two candidates with the most votes for each seat are headed for a runoff election on January 5th. If the Democrats win both of Georgia's seats, they will have the majority in the Senate for the next four years, with Harris as the tie-breaker. Mitch McConnell will no longer be the majority leader able to restrict the Democratic agenda as he did from 2010 on. McConnell demanded that congressional Republicans unite by stifling Obama on everything, even things Republicans support, saying, "The single most important thing we want to achieve is for President Obama to be a one-term president." McConnell continued to block Obama's agenda during his second term and he will continue this obstruction through the Biden years if not stopped.

The two races are as follows with the percentage of votes attained on 11/3: Sen. David Perdue (Republican incumbent) 49.7% vs. Jon Ossoff (Democrat) 48% Sen. Kelly Loeffler (Republican incumbent) 25.9% vs. Rev. Rafael Warnock (Democrat) 32.9% Other Republican candidate 20%, Other Democratic candidate 6.6%, others 14.6% = Total Republican votes 45/9%, total Democratic votes 39.5%, other 14.6%


