Two-thirds of SNAP recipients *can't work*. It's because they're elderly, disabled or children.

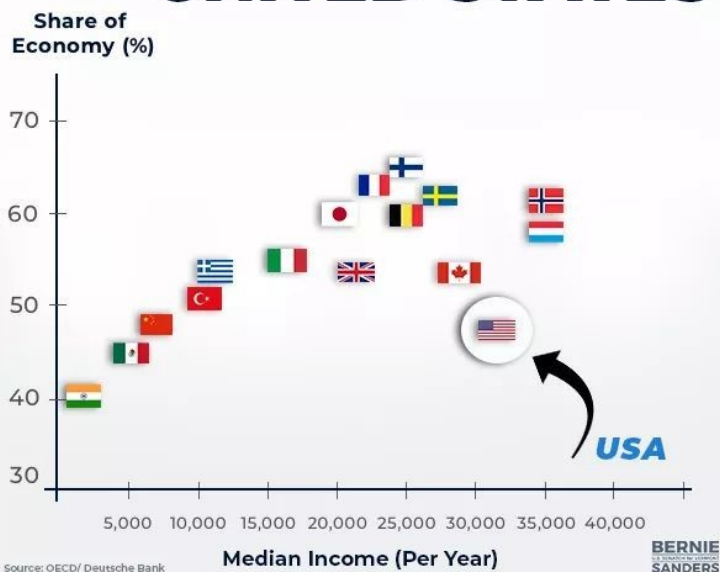
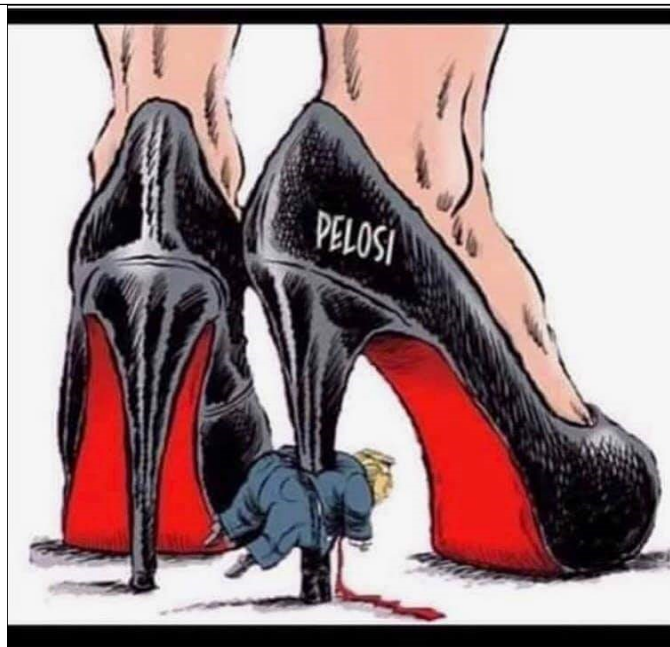
Trump's changes aren't targeted at the "leeches". They affect people who have disabilities but not bad enough to get SSI or SSDI.

That's actually a lot of people who get food stamps. And they only get \$150 - \$170 a month on average

The hardest-hit group are Trump voters. That's 2.5 million white, lower-income, less-educated adults and their families

No, this is Trump being cruel to his base for no reason. Basically the only conceivable way this is making America greater is by starving Trump's voters.

Look at context. Trump cut taxes for billionaires, used \$115 million in taxpayer funds to go golfing, then cut food stamps right before Christmas. He's a laughingstock for world leaders. *That's the opposite of making America great again.*

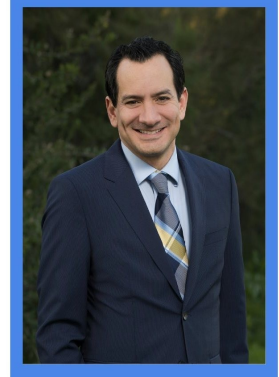
